**CLP6 - 1927 London to London**

**CLP6** is the greatest Canadian semi-official Air Mail rarity. This stamp was specially issued August 1927 for the London, Ontario to London, England flight. This private venture was sponsored by Carling Breweries Ltd., which offered a \$25000 prize for the first Canadian to fly from London, Canada to London, England. A Stinson SM-1 monoplane was provided, christened **Sir John Carling. Terrance B. Tully and James V.**

**Medcalf were selected to be the pilots.** On the morning of the 29th of August 1927, they took off from London, Ontario, but were soon forced to return because of thick fog they encountered over Kingston, Ontario. The flight was delayed until September 1, when another attempt was made and this time they reached Caribou, Maine, before they were forced to land. Again delayed by weather, they finally arrived at Harbour Grace, Newfoundland, 5 days later. From there they would make the flight across the Atlantic. On September 7 the plane set out from Harbour Grace but never arrived in London, England. The flight crashed and was never heard from again. (flight details quoted from the C.A. Longworth-Dames catalogue)

Only 100 stamps were printed and 13 unused copies are known to have survived. Most have small faults similar to this one. 2006 Greene Foundation certificate of authenticity as well as 1987 Dena certificate and stamp signed on reverse by him in pencil.

**"The Hunting, Fishing and Conservation Stamps of Canada"**

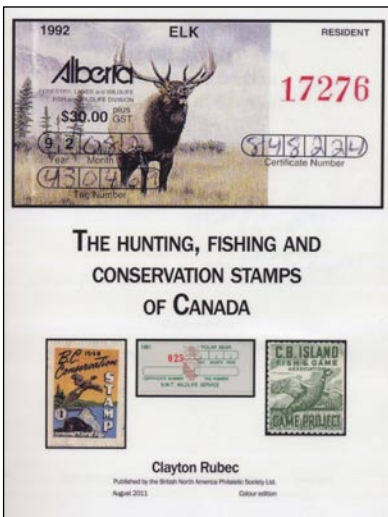
by Clayton Rubec (formerly with the Canadian Wildlife Service of Environment Canada).

This excellent book covers over 4800 stamps mainly issued by governments since 1942 to validate a wide range of hunting and fishing permits. The book includes stamp issues from every province and territory. It also includes stamps issued by non-government organizations to raise funds for wildlife conservation. This includes groups such as World Wildlife Fund Canada, Ducks Unlimited Canada, Pacific Salmon Foundation, Wildlife Habitat Canada, Sportsman's Council of British Columbia, Pitt Waterfowl Management association, Cape Breton Island Fish and Game Association, Winnipeg Game and Fish Association, Fondation de la faune du Québec, ProGuide Publishing, and the Quebec Federation of Fish and Game Associations. The role of over 135 artists who were commissioned to create original artwork for many of these stamps and parallel art print initiatives is examined. The future of the use of stamps in the light of new technology is also discussed as are examples of types of hunting and fishing permits, game seals and hunter badges. 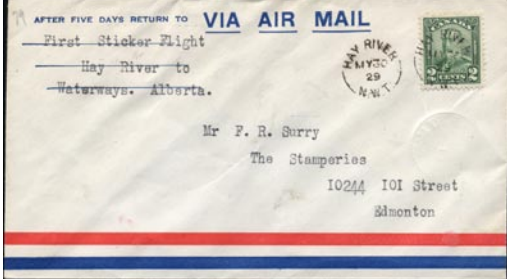
